



Draft of a small tract of land. Containing 7<sup>05</sup> 82<sup>PLS</sup> and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Situate in Salt lick Township Fayette County. Surveyed the 9<sup>th</sup> day of March A. D. 1875. in pursuance of a warrant granted to Jacob Imel for 7 acres of land dated the 12<sup>th</sup> day of January A. D. 1875.

The above mentioned tract is all cleared and a frame School house erected there on, and is a part of a tract originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Godfrey Willey dated the 4<sup>th</sup> day of February A. D. 1794, a part of which I surveyed and returned in Oct-1871 in pursuance of a warrant granted to David A. Wilt dated the 16 day of Sep<sup>r</sup> A. D. 1871, also another part of which I surveyed and returned in Sept-1872 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Samuel Shaffer dated the 24 day of Feb. A. D. 1872.
