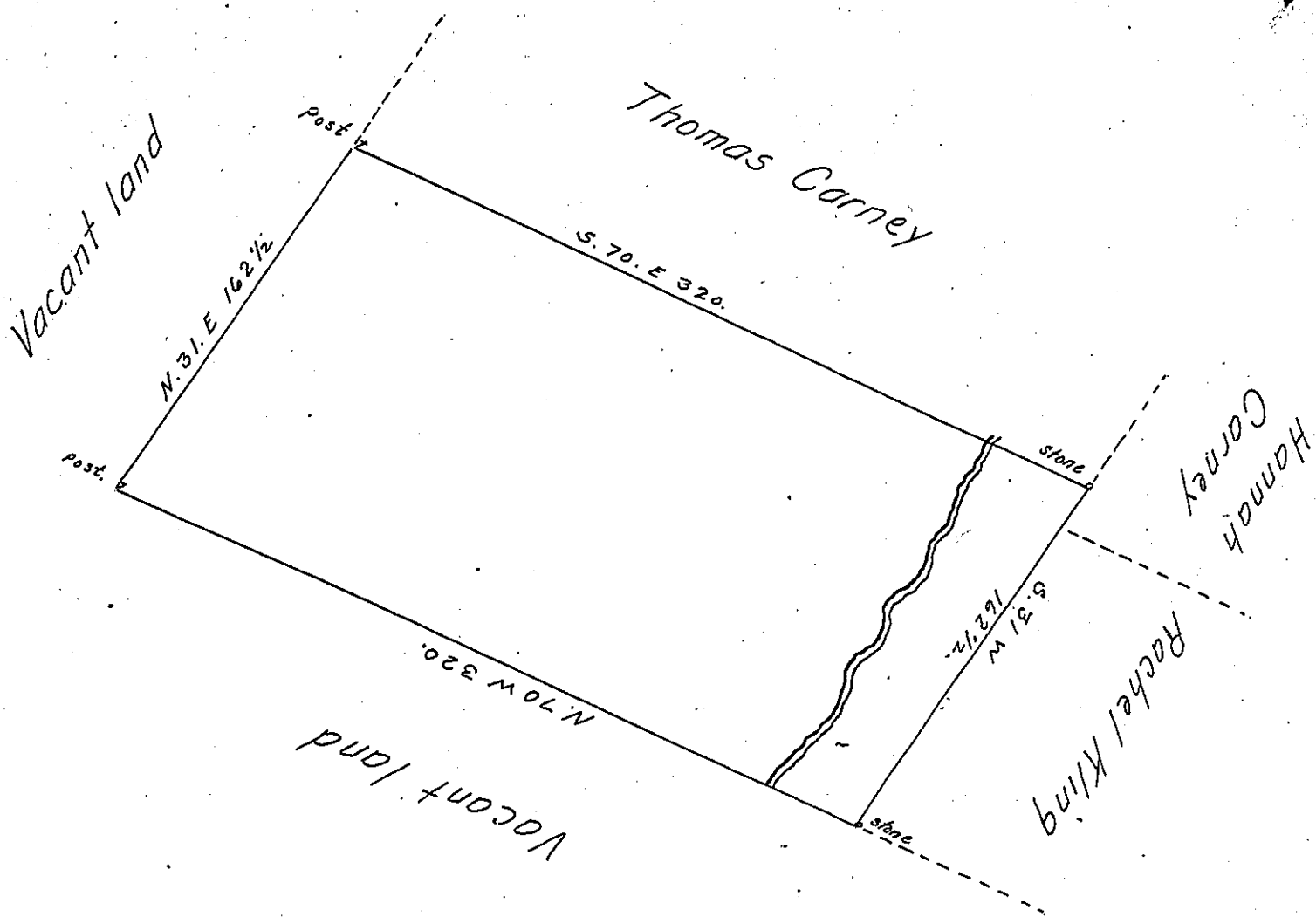


Del. - PIKE.



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 17<sup>th</sup> December 1784 Surveyed  
 the 2<sup>d</sup> October 1787 to Elizabeth Ingram the above described  
 tract of land situate on a branch that Empties into little Bushkill  
 at Smiths Meadows about one mile from Shoholy road and about  
 four miles from Delaware River in Northampton County. Contain-  
 ing Three hundred Acres one hundred and fifty perches and the  
 Allowance of Six p. Cent. & C.
