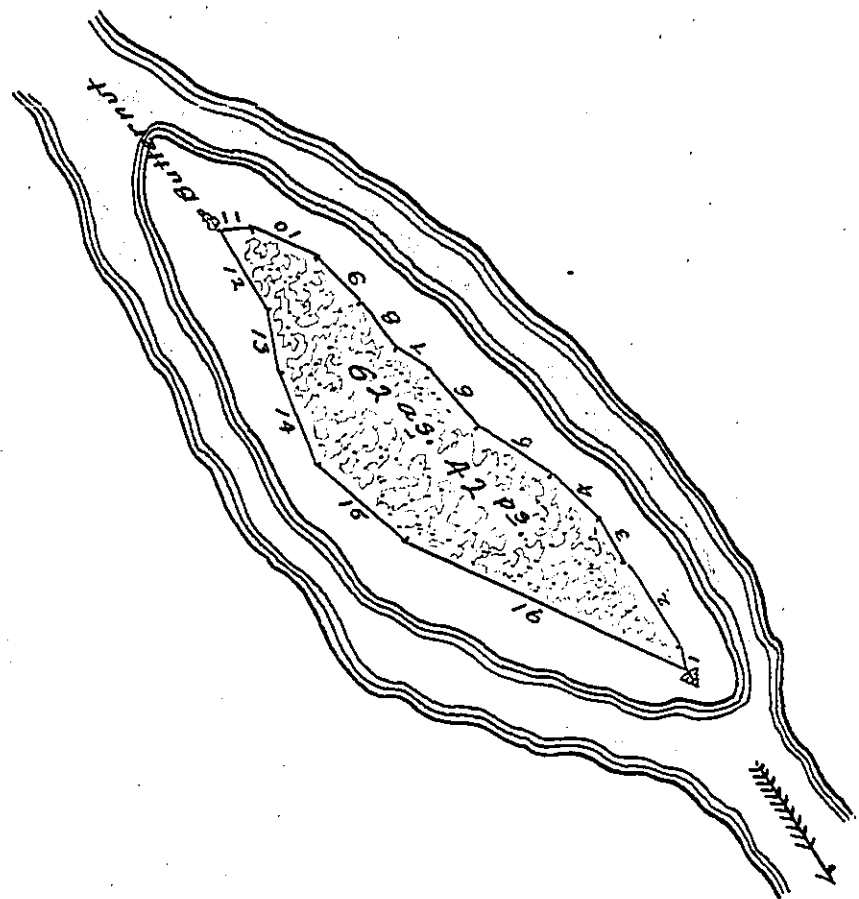


Courses up the river from N. 7
