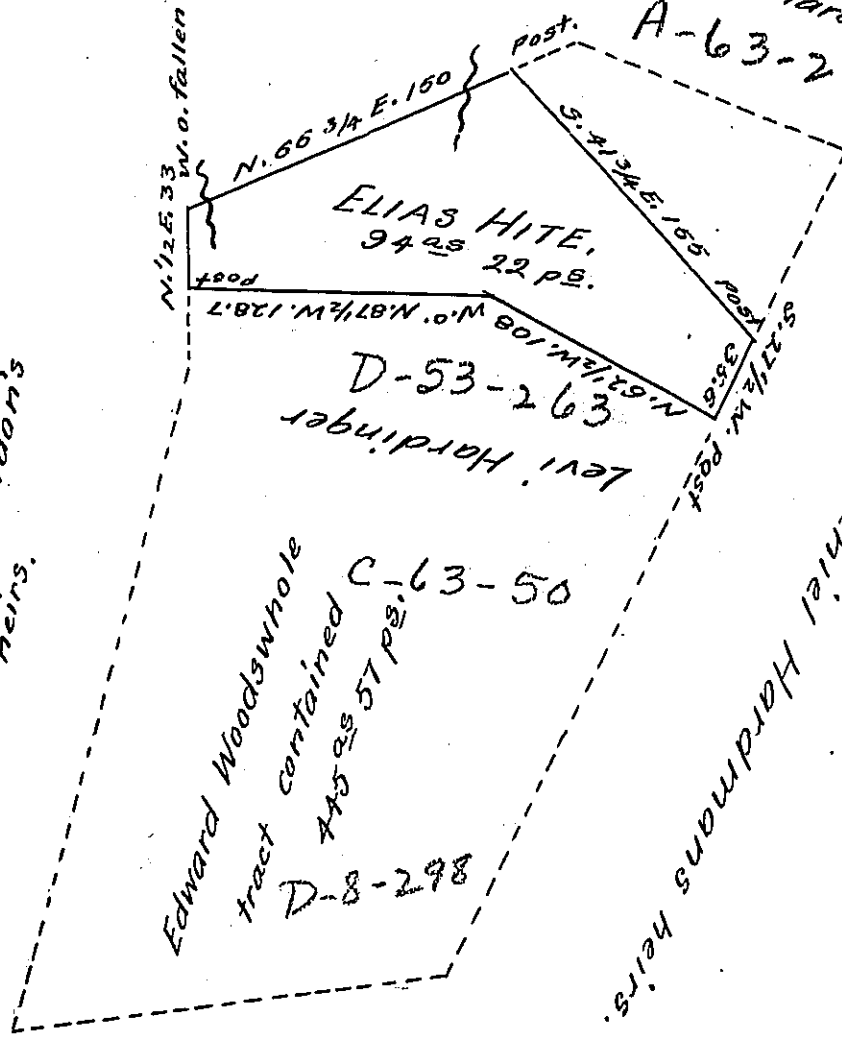

Surveyed by Michael Reed Esq. for Elias Hite the 11th of December 1848, Being part of a tract that originally contained 445^{acs} 57 perches and allowance, Surveyed in pursuance of an order No. 1386 dated the 27th. of September 1766 granted in the name of Edward Woods, Examined, Copied, & returned (to be patented to Elias Hite) the 6th of December 1851.
