



SITUATE on the waters of Buffalo Lick creek in Brothersvalley Township (now) Somerset County (formerly Bedford) the whole tract was surveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> of July 1786 by Alexander McLean Esquire, <sup>then</sup> Deputy Surveyor, in pursuance of a warrant dated the 29<sup>th</sup> of June 1786 granted to the said Walter Hayle for 150 as. the above is a part which was embraced in said warrant. Containing forty Eight acres & one hundred & sixteen perches & allowance. resurveyed this 2<sup>d</sup> day of March 1855  
 return delivered to Jacob Brand present owner the 16<sup>th</sup> March 1855.
