Surveyed November 16th 1808 for Samuel Hughes Esq^r in Pursuance of a Warrant granted Edmond Dunkin Dated Sept^m 6th 1792 by Joseph Snively Jun^r Assnt Surveyor for Thomas Kirby Esq^r late Dep^t Surveyor, as appears by an official Draught there of remaining in my office.

N.B. Part of the above survey is Claimed by James Stoops on his Warrant Dated October 20th 1801.
