A Draught of 28^a 10b perches of land with allowance of 6 percent for Roads & situate in Wayne Township Mifflin County Penna Surveyed June 10th 1852 in pursuance of a Warrant to John Haman for 27^a dated Dec. 10th 1851. Two small houses on this tract with a family in each - about five acres cleared - a public Road running thro it. The part North west of the road (about 2 acres) inclosed by William Laughlin's Heirs - about half of this - stumps rotted & gone - say cleared 20 years or more - The remainder has sound stumps on it - say cleared 10 or 12 years.
