



Situate on the "Hurricane branch of Dunning's creek" including the "Rock lick," formerly in Bedford now in Napier township Bedford county containing 100 acres 88 perches and allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Surveyed by James Allison Esq for Joseph Hewitt the 18th of May 1852 in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of Joseph Rowser for 100 acres dated the 2nd of April 1793. Courses according to the true bearings.
