



Situate in Chapman township Union County containing one hundred & seventy three acres & forty six perches & allowance of six percent for roads &c. adjoining W^m Kelley Abraham Gougler George Gougler John Witmer Blossers heirs Philip Arnold Michael Brubacher Benjamin Yarger & Simon Shalley. Resurveyed for Jacob Houser one hundred and sixty five acres & thirty nine perches & allowance in virtue of his Warrant dated the first day of August 1814 for one hundred acres and that part contained within the dotted lines containing eight acres seven perches & allowance is part of a tract of land surveyed to Joseph Simons in virtue of his Warrant dated the 6th day of August 1792 four hundred acres and held in possession by Jacob Houser upwards of twenty five years. A Warrant was issued to John F. Stoll May 20, 1848 for the same but being in the possession of Jacob Houser and included in the survey of Joseph Simons I have thought proper to include it in Jacob Housers survey. June 6th 1848 By
