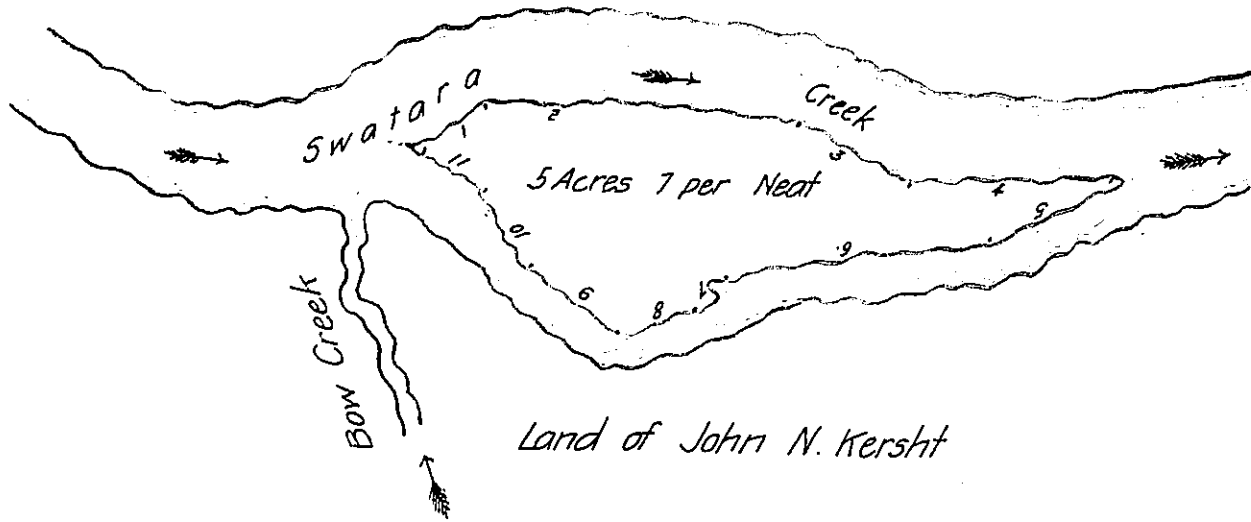

Surveyed January 10<sup>th</sup> 1814 for John Nicholas Kersht the above described Island situate in Swatara Creek at and below the mouth of Bow Creek opposite to land of Levi G. Hollingsworth & William Hamilton on the Eastern or London Derry Shore and opposite to Land of the J. N. Kersht on the Western or Hanover Shore of sd. Creek in West Hanover Township Dauphin County Containing Five Acres Seven Perches Strict measure by his Warrant dated the 8<sup>th</sup> day of January 1814
