



Situate on the East side of Yough-River about one mile below the mouth of Buffalo Lick Creek in Brothers Valley Township now Somerset County (late Bedford) and surveyed the 29th day of July 1795 by Alexander McClean Esquire then Deputy Surveyor In pursuance of a warrant granted to John Kurtz dated the 16th day of December 1785 as appears by his Official draught remaining in my Office & now Certified & Returned the 21st day of February 1815
