



Situate late in Reading Township - now in Washington Township in the County of York. Originally surveyed on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D. 1765 by Charles Lukens late D.S. In Pursuance of a Warrant for 100<sup>a</sup> granted to Martin Klawdy bearing date the 28<sup>th</sup> day of August 1742. Resurveyed by the old lines on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of August 1804. And now at the request of the present owner Jacob Hollinger et al. the same is calculated examined and found correct and at his request returned for confirmation the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1813
