Being part of a larger Tract of 100 <sup>00</sup>/<sub>00</sub> & 25 perches & allowance which was Originally surveyed by George Stevenson late D.S. on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of August 1752 for Baltzer Knalzer in pursuance of a Warrant for 100 <sup>00</sup>/<sub>00</sub> more or less (directed to be surveyed in two pieces) Granted to the said Baltzer Knalzer bearing date the 10<sup>th</sup> day of September 1750 Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 31<sup>st</sup> day of May 1814 at the request of Michael Melhorn the present owner who desired the same to be returned for confirmation
