



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 A Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following of a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland numbered in the general Plan of said Town Seventy Six and granted to David Kennedy, containing in Breadth East & West Fifty seven feet Six Inches and in length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet, bounded Eastward by River Alley Northward by Lot number Seventy five, Westward by Broad Way and Southward by Blackberry Street, as by the general Plan of said Town remaining in the Surveyor General's will appear.
