



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following for Andrew Gibson on a Certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Two hundred and thirty four Containing in Breadth East and West on the South side of Blackberry Street Sixty feet, and in Length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet Bounded Northward by Blackberry Street aforesaid, Eastward by Lot Number Two hundred and thirty three, Southward by Gooseberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number Two hundred and thirty five. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 23^d day of August 1774 for George Keiser by Warrant dated the 19th day of Aug^t Instant.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twelfth day of July 1905.
