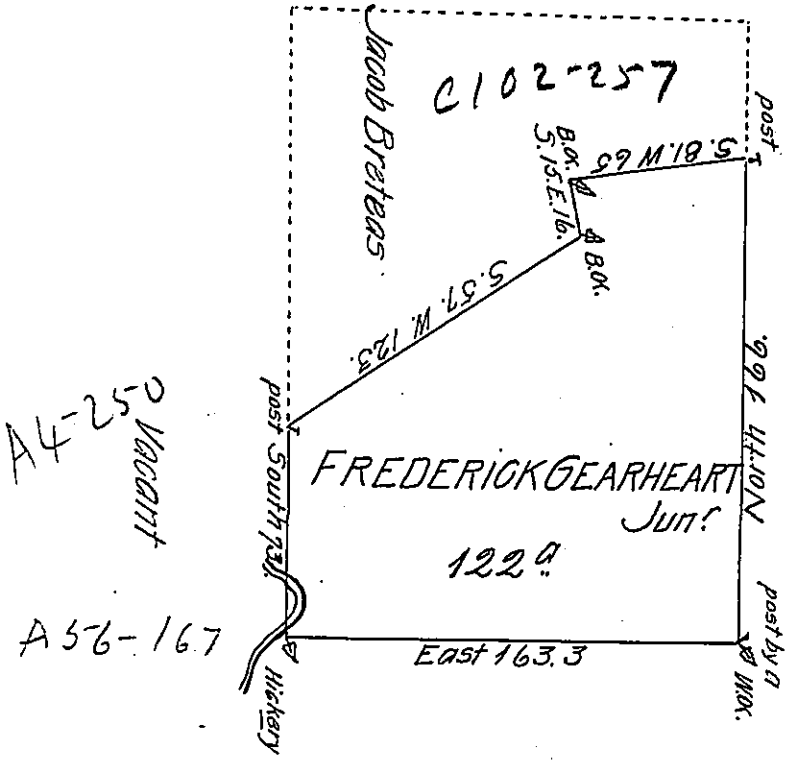

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 1st day of April 1737 there was Surveyed on the 16th day of June 1737 to Albrecht Klotz Two hundred Acres & Allowance of Six P Cent Situate in Tulpehocken Township formerly in Lancaster County now in Berks County. The above One hundred and Twenty Two Acres and Allowance of 6 P Cent part of the said 200^a is Returned into the Secretary's Office the 18th day of January 1775 for Frederick Gearheart Junr.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twelfth day of July 1905.
