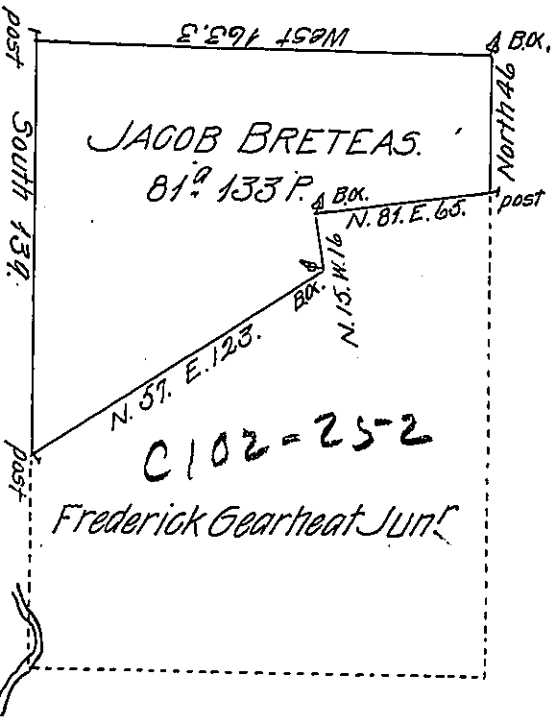


Long the Summer Hill

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1737 There was Surveyed on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1737 to Albrecht Klotz Two Hundred Acres and Allowance of Six P. Cent Situate in Tulpehocken Township formerly in Lancaster County now in Berks County The above Eighty One Acres and One hundred and Thirty three Perches and Allowance of 6 P Cent part of the said 200<sup>a</sup> is Returned into the Secretary's Office the 18<sup>th</sup> day of January 1775 for Jacob Breteas.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this eighth day of August 1905.
