In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 on a Certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland for Joseph M^cGarrol marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Two Hundred and forty One Containing in Breadth East and West Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two Hundred and Thirty feet Bounded Southward by Poakberry Street Eastward by Center Alley Northward by Gooseberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number Two hundred and forty Two Returned into the Secretarys Office the 27th day of February 1776 for George Keiser by Warrant of the 23^d day of the same Month.
