



Situate in Codorus Township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 31<sup>1/2</sup> & 130 Perches and allowance Being part of a larger Tract of Land Resurveyed by the old lines Per Moses McClean late D.S. In pursuance of a Warrant for 150<sup>ac</sup> Granted to Daniel Keenboard and Jacob Hoffer bearing date the 14<sup>th</sup> day of March 1755 And afterwards to-wit on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of September 1800 Divided off from the said larger Tract of land—and now at the Request of the present owner James Ruth I am desired to make Return of the Draught as Calculated examined and corrected the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August AD 1809.
