



Situate in Codorus Township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 40<sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> & 36 Perches and allowance Being part of a larger Tract of 83<sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> and allowance which was Originally Surveyed on the 26<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup> days of September 1789 by Moses Mc Clean late D.S. In pursuance of a Warrant for 40<sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Granted to Henry Strickhauser bearing date the 19<sup>th</sup> day of February AD 1789 Divided off from the said larger Tract of Land in March 1804 for James Ruth the present owner who desired me to make Return of the Draught as Calculated and Examined the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August AD 1809
