



By Vertue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries bearing Date the Eighth Day of March An^o Dom. 1737 Surveyed to Ephraim Little a Tract of Land on Little Shu-kasa alonge Creek in the Township of Donegal & County of Lancaster Beginning at a Marked Hickery a corner of John Galbreaths Land thence North seventy five Deg^s East one hundred & three perches to a Black oak thence North one hundred & seventy nine perches to a White oak then South Sixty Deg^s West one hundred & ninety seven perches to a hickery thence by S^d Galbreaths Land - thence South 30 Deg^s East forty perches to a post South thirty five Deg^s East Eighty nine perches & a half - to ye Beginning Cont. One Hundred & Twenty Eight acres & the usual allowance for Roads &c.

Surveyed ye 14th of April An^o - 1739.
