 the fifth day of June 1734 Surveyed unto Isaac Levant
 a tract of Land Situate in Oley in the County of Philada
 Beginning at a post a Corner of his other Land thence
 by Land of _____ Weeks North East Eighty two perches
 to a post in a line of Harris Martin Careys Land thence by
 the same and Vacant Land North West one hundred
 and Sixty Seven perches to a Black Oak Sapling thence
 by Vacant Land South West Eighty two perches to a
 hickery another Corner of sd Levants land thence by the
 same South East one hundred and sixty Seven perches
 to the place of Beginning Containing Eighty acres and
 a half with the usual allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent.
