



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the  
 Twenty seventh day of June 1734 Surveyed unto Michael Erel-  
 lich a tract of Land Situate near a branch of Tohickon called  
 Three mile Run in the County of Bucks Beginning at a Black  
 Oak a Corner of Francis Lewis's land thence by the same &  
 land of Adam Scheffer North West one hundred and Twenty-  
 seven perches to a post thence by land of sd Adam Scheffer  
 North East one hundred and forty perches and by Vacant Land  
 Sixty nine perches to a Wt. Oak thence by Vacant land South  
 East one hundred and twenty seven perches to a post thence South  
 West by Vacant land two hundred and nine perches to the place  
 of Beginning Containing one hundred and Fifty five acres with the  
 usual allowance of Six  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cent Surveyed Sept. 23<sup>d</sup> 1734
