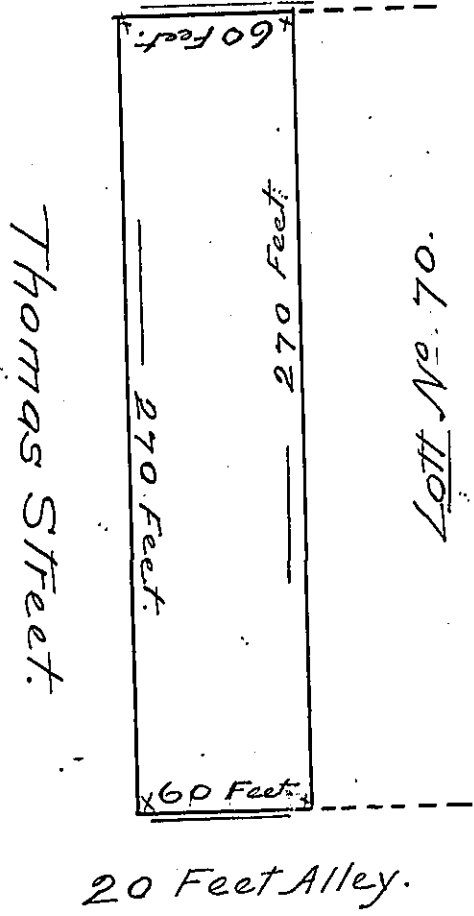


Callowhill Street.
