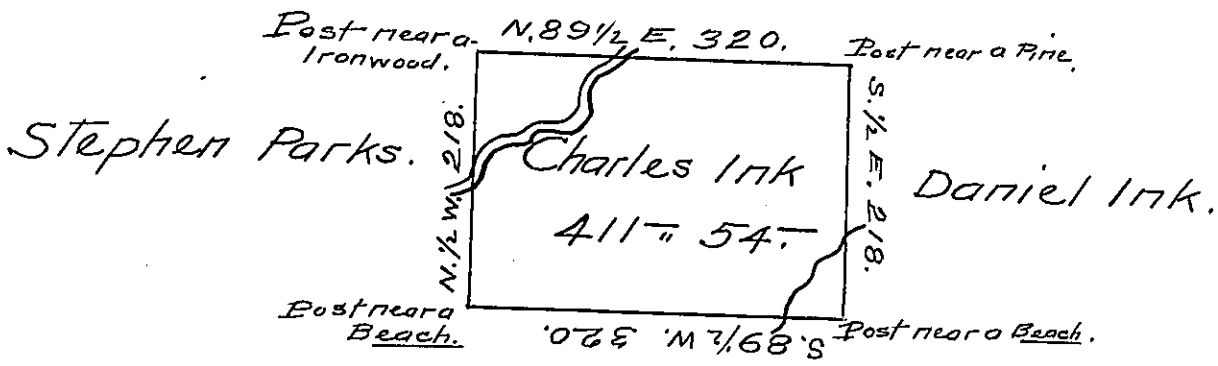

 1799. Containing four hundred & Eleven acres -
 and fifty four perches & the allowance of six Per cent.
