



The Drought for Casper Wolf, Part of a Survey made By Virtue of a warrants that Jacob Kimberlin obtained from the Honourable the Proprietaries of Pennsylvania Bearing Date the Tenth day of August Anno Do. 1747

Situated in Robinson township, Berks County, Containing Ninety Seven Acres and one Hundred and twenty perches and the allowane of Six Per Cent.

April 30<sup>th</sup>. 1771.

Warr<sup>t</sup> dated 24<sup>th</sup> Feb. 1749.
