It might be stated that on the 22nd day of January 1828, certain lines were run at the instance of Andrew Knerr, including by mistake about 30° part of the old Survey of Michael Kroll, and also land to the North of the above as shown by the dotted lines, which Survey said Knerr never called on me to return, until after I rec'd a description 50° warrant in the name of Jacob Heller, and both warrants have now been Surveyed without interference with old Surveys, and are returned accordingly.
