The above described tract of land containing 406 acres, 47 perches, and allowance of six per cent. for roads, &c. situated in Fairfield township, Crawford county, and at the time of making the same, James Kendle was residing thereon, and there was built a house fit for the habitation of man, and there appeared to be upwards of ten acres of the land cleared, fenced and in a state of cultivation, and that the same was divided as above stated, between
