



Situate in Shrewsbury Township, in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 173^a & 133 perches and the usual Allowance of 6 Per Cent &c. Being part of a larger Tract of 217 1/2^a and Allowance of Land, which was Originally Surveyed by William Matthews, late D.S. on the 17th of 11th Mo^o 1764. for Tobias Bier, In Pursuance of a Warrant for 200^a Granted to Abraham Keener, bearing date the 23^d day of September A.D. 1762 or 1763. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land, on the 20th day of October A.D. 1790.

And now at the request of the owner Henry Rehman, the same has been Calculated, examined and found to be Correct, and at his request Returned for Confirmation the 5th day of November A.D. 1816.
