



Rt to Commence 1st Mar. 1769

A Plan of a Lot of ground situate of the East Side of George Street in the Town of York marked on the General Plan of the said Town Number 50 Containing in Breadth on the said street fifty seven feet and six inches and in Length to a Twenty Feet Alley two hundred and Fifty feet. Bounded Westward with George Street aforesaid Northward with a Lot Number 49 Eastward with a Twenty feet Alley and Southward with a Lot Number 51 Entered on the Plan of the said Town and surveyed for George Keentz who has built an house on the same agreeable To the Conditions of settling the Towne

Certified at York the Second day of July 1761.
