



By virtue of a Warrant Dated at Philadelphia on the 29th Day of March Anno 1750 granted to Christopher Krouse. The above described Two Tracts of Land situate in Upper Milford Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania. The one containing Twenty Acres 130 perches, and the usual Allowance for Roads, and the other containing Thirteen Acres and 154 perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads. Being together Thirty four Acres and 124 perches and the usual Allowance was surveyed for the said Christopher Krouse on the 7th day of September Anno 1757.
