



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the 13th day of August 1734 Surveyed unto Gili Krim a Tract of Land situate in the County of Bucks Beginning at a hickery in the line of Hans Clinor's Land thence by the same North Eighty Degrees East thirty perches to a White Oak Sapling a corner of said Clinor's Land thence the same Course by Vacant Land sixty two perches to a post thence by Vacant Land south Ten degrees East one hundred and eighty Five perches to a small hickery sapling thence by Vacant Land South Eighty degrees West Ninety two perches to a White Oak Sapling thence by Vacant Land North Ten degrees West one hundred and Eighty Five perches to y^e place of Beginning Containing one hundred acres with the usual allowance of six p Cent.
