



The draught of a tract of land called "addition to small Lott" situate on the north side of Juniata in the County of Cumberland containing one hundred eleven acres 23 perches with the usual allowance of six acres P Cent for roads surveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> day of July Anno Dom 1768 In pursuance of a warrant from the Hon<sup>ble</sup> the proprietaries to James Kyle bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 28<sup>th</sup> day of October Anno Dom 1765 (agreeable to the determination of the board of property in the case between Kyle and White of the 30<sup>th</sup> of June 1768)
