 Containing two hundred eighty acres & one perch & allowance of six per cent &c. originally surveyed the 17th day of June 1768 on an order of survey No. 4672 granted to William Nisbet dated the 31st day of December 1767 divided as above the 22nd day of November 1833 for Jacob Keller containing forty two acres and one hundred thirteen perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c.
