Situate on the waters of Little Sandy Creek in Wharton township Fayette County (Surveyed 12th - 13th Decr. 1794) and resurveyed the 8th day of April 1831 in pursuance of two warrants in the name of Henry Klinger dated the 4th day of August 1794 one for 300 the other for 100 acres this land was surveyed by McClean in 1794 and called 419 3/4 acs & all upon a resurvey and recalculations there appears to be but 419 1/4 acs & all there is 5 or 6 acres in a state of cultivation at this time has been improved about 7 years a cabbie and a family of Joseph Carroll residing there on
