



By Virtue of a warrant dated the 23^d day of May A.D. 1836 granted to Elizabeth Everitt widow of the borough of Easton surveyed the 27th day of May A.D. 1836 to the said Elizabeth Everitt the above described tract of land situate in Williams Township Northampton County containing twenty acres and forty four perches and the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c.
