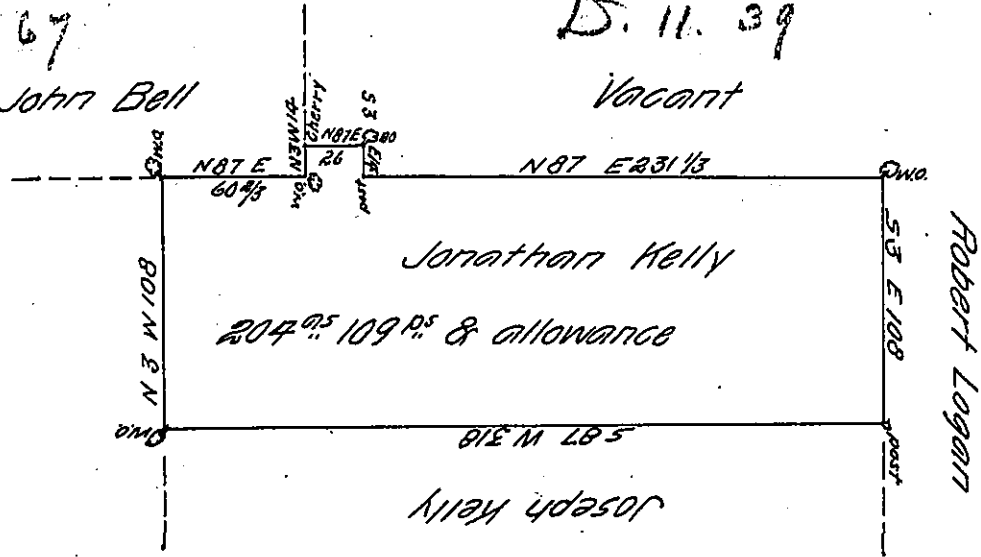

Cochran Esq. S. G. Jas. Irvine D.S. Pennsylvania
