



A Draught of a piece of land situate in Windsor Township in the County of York containing as above set forth 139.60 prs and allowances &c. which is a part of a larger tract of 99.05 103 prs &c allowance which was surveyed on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1806 for Ulrich Weaver in pursuance of a warrant for 100.05 granted to Charles Klugh bearing date the 10<sup>th</sup> day of November 1773 and in pursuance of a decision of the board of property dated the 9<sup>th</sup> day of April 1806 since resurveyed and divided the said larger tract &c now on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1836 having examined the same and found to be correct &c and being requested to make return of the above for the heirs of Samuel Sherk deceased &c.
