



Situate in Windsor Township in the County of York containing as above set forth 10⁹⁵ and allowance being part of a larger tract of 160⁹⁵ & 90 perches and allowance of land which was originally surveyed by William Matthews D. S. on the 25th of the 6th Month 1766 ^{for Nicholas Cowfelt} in pursuance of a Warrant for 100⁹⁵ granted to Henry Lakes bearing date the 3rd day of December Anno Domini 1762 and now resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land the 11th & 12th days of October 1810 at the request of the present owner Samuel Sherrick who desired me to make return thereof for confirmation.
