



Situate on the great Glade of Stony Creek North of the road leading from Bedford to Pittsburgh through the Glades in Stony Creek Township Somerset County formerly Brothers Valley Township Bedford County the original (called "392 $\frac{1}{2}$ " but containing 390 $\frac{1}{2}$ 166 $\frac{1}{2}$) of which this is part) surveyed the 3rd day of May 1774 in pursuance of a warrant to Jacob Kimmel dated 20th Sept^r 1773 as appears by the official draught thereof remaining in my office. The above described part (195 $\frac{1}{2}$ 33 $\frac{1}{2}$) is now returned for Matthew Black this 10th Dec^r A.D. 1811.
