



A draught of a tract of land called — situate on the southerly side of the North East Branch of Susq^a River about four or five miles from Niscopeck - in the County of Northumberland containing two hundred and six acres and one hundred and forty five perches besides the usual allowance of 6 P. Gent for roads surveyed the 10th day of June 1773 for Abraham Leddon in pursuance of a warrant dated the fifth day of June 1773
