



By Virtue of a warrant dated the 18th October 1816 Surveyed the 25 October 1816 to Anthony Kintz the above described tract of land situate in Hamilton township Northampton County containing two hundred and three acres twenty eight perches and the allowance of six P cent 80^a

Henry Vanderslice Surveyed the above land the 25 August 1769 but I know not on what right There is a dwelling house on each tract in which a family actually resides at this time

Christopher Bittenbender claims 100^a of the above land by warrant of the 11 October 1816 taken for unimproved land

Since the above land was surveyed the following warrant was first put in my hands viz the 26 Nov^r 1816.

John Bittenbender 50 acres of land adjoining or near the land of Nicholas Scull on the big creek in the said County of Bucks dated the 6 Nov^r 1758 This warrant doth not describe the land the big creek is Paha Paha creek
