

Situate on the Waters of the West branch of the River Susquehanna in  
 Stewarts Valley Huntingdon County. Surveyed the 6<sup>th</sup> day of October 1792 to Francis  
 Johnston in pursuance of his Warrant dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of July 1792. Containing  
 four hundred and fourteen acres twenty eight perches & the allowance of six P Cent  
 for Roads &c.
