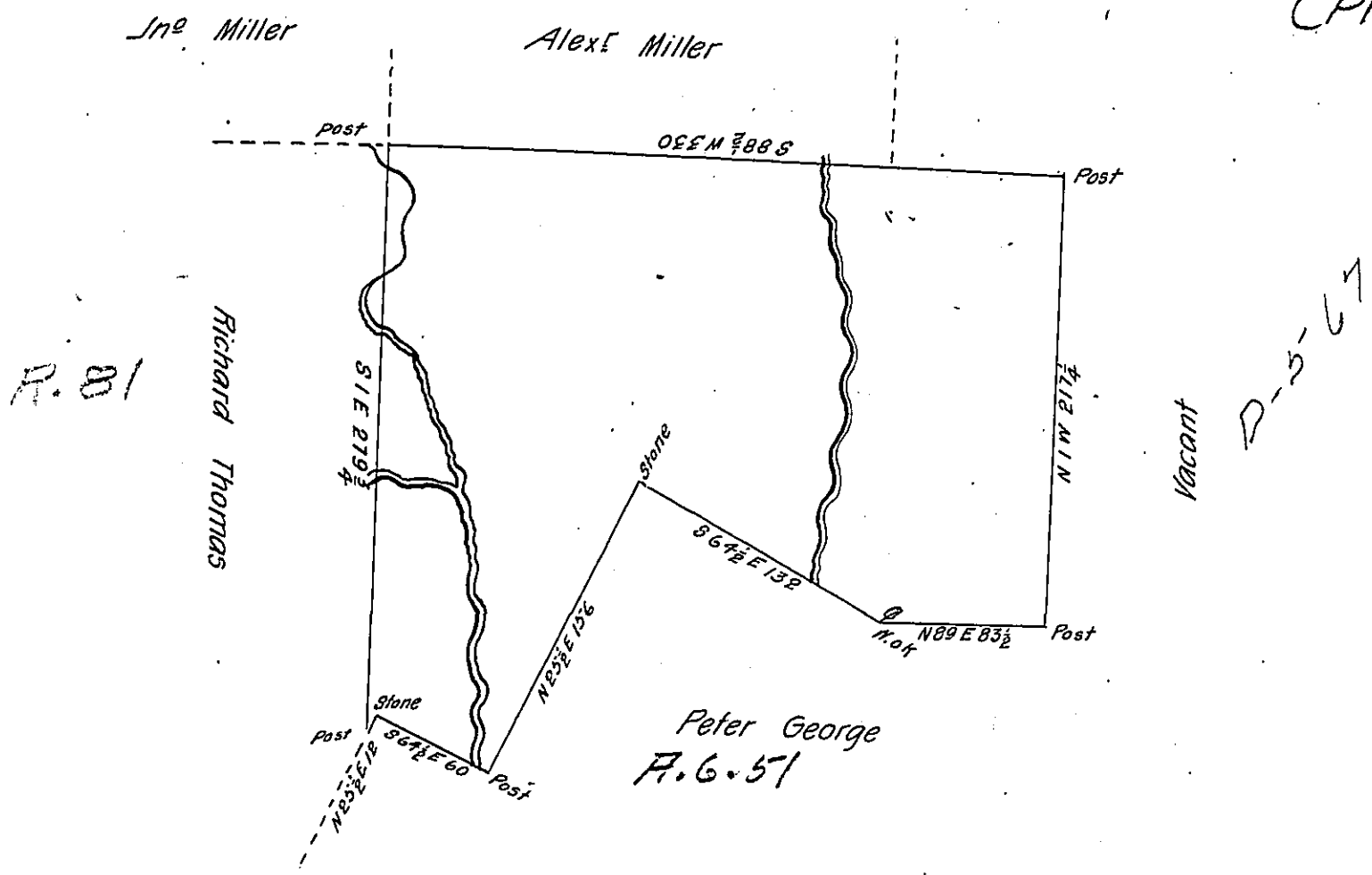


Bl. Grove -
