 1785. Situate on the Waters of Ten Mile Creek. Including her Improvement in the town-
 ship of Anwell in the County of Washington. Called Sugar Camp. Containing three
 hundred and ^{sixty three} acres with the usual allowance of six Per Cent for Roads.
