The said John Potts sold the Residue of the said Warrant unto John Leshor of Oly. The above discribed Tract of Land Situate in District Township Berks County. Surveyd unto John Leshor containing Eighty four acres and ¹⁰¹ ~~151~~ perches and the allowance of Six P Cent which Survey Compleats the full quantity of the said Warrant. Surveyd the 19 day of May 1786.
