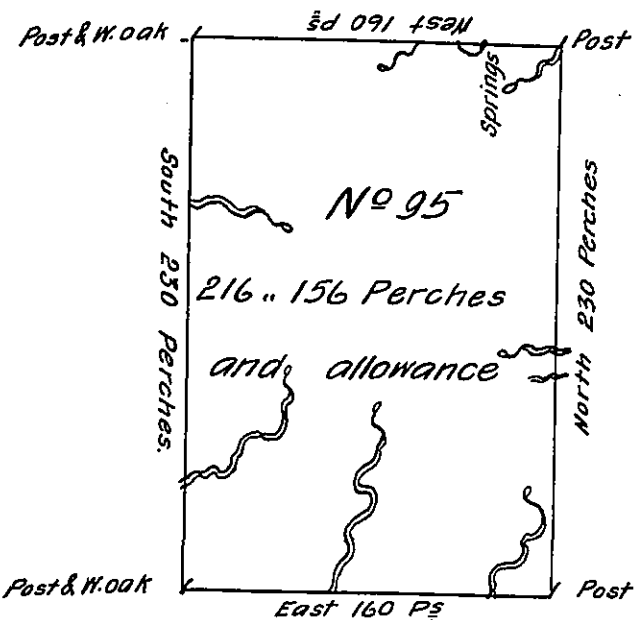

In Pursuance of an Act of Assembly Passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of  
 March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by Virtue of a Commis-  
 sion under the hand and seal of Office from John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor Gen<sup>l</sup> for  
 the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August  
 1783. The above tract of land containing two hundred and sixteen acres and  
 156 P<sup>s</sup> and allowance of 6 P. Cent for Roads &c. Was surveyed on the 25<sup>th</sup>  
 day of June 1785 by
