



A. Draught of a Tract of land, situate in Springfield Township York County, containing  $128\frac{1}{2}^{\text{as}}$  & allowance &c. Part B. Containing  $91\frac{1}{2}^{\text{as}}$  and allowance part of  $100^{\text{as}}$  52 perches, originally surveyed on the 17<sup>th</sup> of the 1<sup>st</sup> Mo. 1767, for Jacob Kerot, in pursuance of a Warrant for  $50^{\text{as}}$  dated the 31<sup>st</sup> day of May, 1762. And part C. containing  $37^{\text{as}}$  part of a larger tract, originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 20<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1785, granted to Casper Glatfelter. And now at the request of the owner Samuel Kerot, the above has been calculated, examined &c, and at his request, returned for confirmation the 25<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1864,
