



A Draft of a tract of land containing 257<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> 52<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> & allowance being part of a larger tract of land containing 307<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> 52<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> &c. Surveyed by Robert M. Greer D.S. for Samuel Moore the 24<sup>th</sup> of April, 1770, in pursuance of an order No. 659, dated the 3<sup>d</sup> of April, 1769. Constructed for Patenting May 14<sup>th</sup> 1868, from the original draft in name of Thomas Moore, and a draft of the original survey warranted and Patented to Peter Parckment 13<sup>th</sup> October, 1832.
