



Draft of a tract of land situated in Clearfield Township in the County of Cambria, Pennsylvania containing (in both pieces) one hundred and eighty-six acres and seventy-four perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed for Lewis Carroll the 5th day of April A.D. 1870. being a part of a larger tract 307 Ac. 50 perches and allowance of six per cent originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to George Krisee dated the 24th April, 1837.
